10. Additional provisions of the articles:

8. (a) No substantial (greater than 25%) part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attemptation to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws), and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision set forth herein, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible for federal income tax purposes.

9. In the event of the entire or partial termination, dissolution or winding up of the corporation in any manner of for any reason whatsoever, the assets of the corporation which remain after payment, or making provision for payment, of all liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to, and only to, one or more organizations exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be distributed by the Court of Common Pleas of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, or as otherwise provided by law, exclusively to such exempt organizations as the Court shall determine.
