WeConservePA seeks a summer intern to create illustrations and design graphics in support of WeConservePA's education, advocacy, and marketing efforts using print and digital mediums. The internship is geared towards rising juniors and seniors majoring in studio art, graphic design, illustration, or similar fields of study. Others with equivalent or greater levels of experience will also be considered.

Timeframe: 10-12 weeks in May-August

Hours: 22.5 to 37.5 hours per week depending on the candidate and their needs

Location: a mixture of work from home and in office to be determined (WeConservePA staff typically work two days a week from home)

(a candidate must have reliable transportation to and from WeConservePA's downtown Harrisburg)

Skills: WeConservePA is seeking candidates who at minimum have:

- Skills and sample work to share in illustration and/or graphic design;
- Visual messaging skills evidenced in their portfolio work; and,
- Digital application skills.

WeConservePA offers:

- Professional level tools: The summer intern in art and design will have access to professional level design and media management software (Adobe Creative Suite and more), professional office software (Microsoft Office suite, Teams communication tools, and Asana project management software) and will be provided a laptop computer for the duration of their internship, if needed.
- Compensation: \$13.50/hour (no benefits)
- Balanced, flexible work from home and in-office schedule; a relaxed office environment with supportive colleagues who appreciate the arts.
- Collaboration: The summer art and design intern will work directly with our communications specialist, advocacy manager, and other staff as needed, balancing collaborative work with independent project completion time.

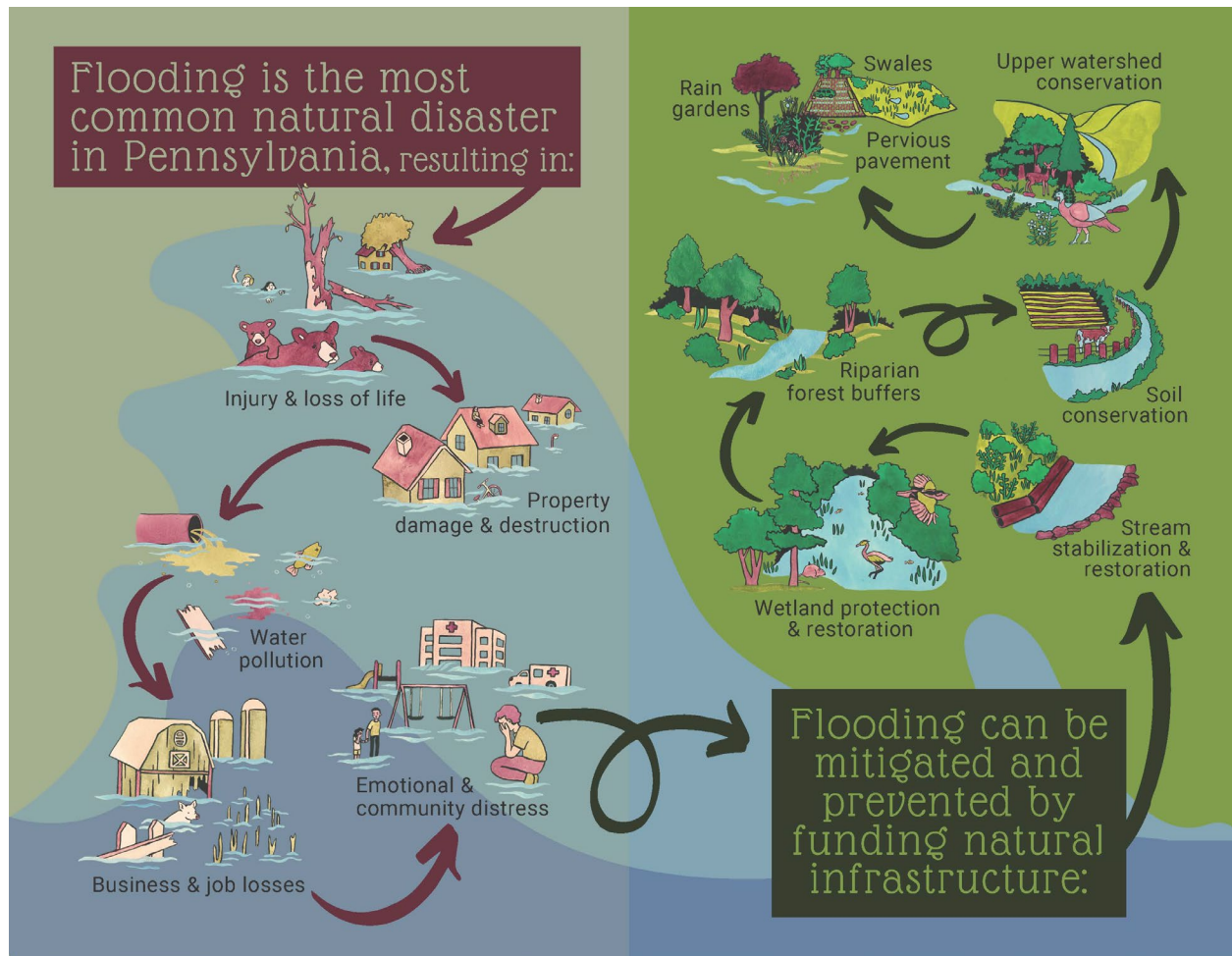

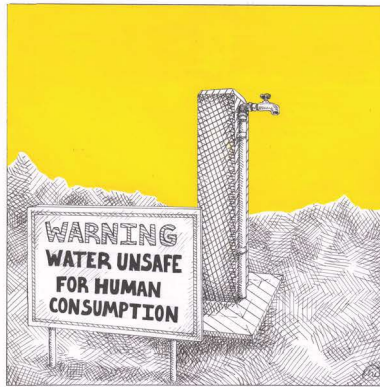
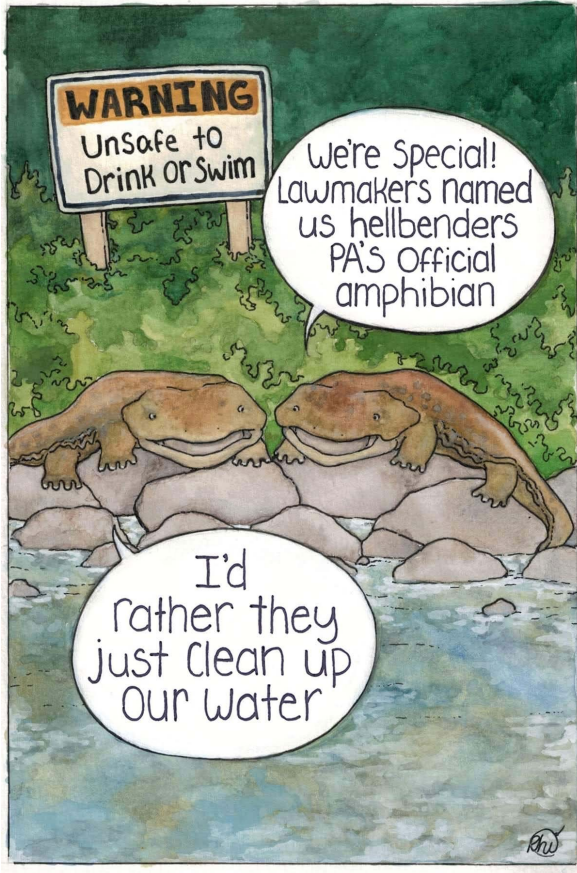
How to Apply:
