



Conservation Easement Intern

Natural Lands, a vibrant, regional, non-profit organization and leader in land conservation, natural resource stewardship, and public engagement, seeks a Conservation Easement Intern to join our team at our headquarters on the Hildacy Preserve in Media, Pennsylvania.

Job Summary

The Conservation Easement Intern will work closely with Conservation Easement Program staff to assist with annual easement monitoring tasks. The intern will assist with report and letter writing and compilation, as well as easement review, interpretation, and reserved rights tracking.

The Conservation Easement Intern will leave this opportunity with an understanding of the day-to-day work required within an easement program of an accredited land trust.

The internship will start in late September, lasting 14 weeks, and requires an average of 20 hours per week. Hours will be flexible based on the intern's availability and class schedule (if applicable).
